Use a/an when you mention one thing for the first time. Use the when the reader knows which thing you mean. Use no article for general plural or uncountable ideas.

Use	Form / signal	Example
a/an	one thing; first mention	There is a library near my home.
the	specific/known thing	The library is popular with students.
No article	general plural nouns	Communities need safe streets.
Common places	the city centre/countryside	I live near the city centre.
